LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF LOS ANGELES

Thank You, LWVLA Voter Service Volunteers

Now that the November 4, 2008 election has come to a close, we would like to thank you for the hard work and dedication you provided LWVLA's Voter Service efforts.

Thanks to you, LWVLA's office volunteers responded to close to 1,000 various inquiries from members of the public, League members staffed over 90 speaker's bureau requests, a minimum of ten new LWVLA members were recruited, and energetic members and interns serviced approximately eight voter registration efforts. As a partnership with LWV/LAC, funds from an American Express grant expanded our efforts to include the distribution of over 45,000 copies of the *Election Info* brochures, 15 candidate forums, many of which were shown live and in multiple reruns on local government television stations and/or streamed on the Internet, and the videotaping of one-on-one interviews with ten candidates for five Superior Court judgeships countywide.

As if that were not enough, the program co-chairs and study committee chairs were diligent in providing timely analysis and recommendations to the Board on six local measures. The public received close to 30,000 pieces of literature on LWVLA's positions.

These combined efforts and activities generated mass publicity for the LWVLA. It also maintained our credibility as one of the lead organizations providing objective and professional election and voter support resources in the Los Angeles region.

As a matter of fact, efforts are underway to begin preparations for the March 3, 2009 municipal election. We have already begun receiving requests for speakers – can you imagine! Currently, we are de-briefing the League's November 2008 election process in order to improve our system and delivery of services.
